Athletic Destinations Winter 2018-2019

This winter season, Lawrence High School will be providing an academic support program to help give a structured environment to athletes to work on homework as well as get academic support in their classes from certified LHS teachers.

This program, called Athletic Destinations, will take place during the times on the selected dates in room 703. Students should arrive when the program starts each day, but may also arrive late (when their practice ends) and are expected to stay until the program ends at 6pm. If students are going to leave before 6, we ask that the parent/guardian come to the front security desk to have the player excused from the program and escorted to the doors.

There will be a certified teacher in the room who will have access to the students grades and assignments to help them stay organized, and the room the program takes place in has many of the textbooks and resources students use throughout the day. Trips to lockers will not be allowed.
