Program Overview

The Lawrence Township Public School District Preschool Program is a comprehensive program that services typically developing and special needs 3- and 4-year-old children. Programs will be held at Lawrenceville and Ben Franklin Elementary Schools. Placement of typically developing children into the program is based on the needs of each student and current openings. Children with special needs are placed in the program through identification, evaluation, and eligibility procedures as outlined in New Jersey Administrative Code. Tuition-paying and low-income eligible children are placed in the program through an application and a lottery procedure. The goal of our program is to provide students with an excellent early childhood learning experience. Currently, Lawrence Township Public School District offers a variety of programs that are designed to meet the specific needs of each child. **Please note that this application is for LOW-INCOME ELIGIBLE families.**

Eligibility

- Must be 3 or 4 years of age (no older than 5 years of age on or before October 1, 2023)
- Must be a resident of Lawrence Township
- Must be toilet trained
- Must be deemed eligible according to federal guidelines

Enrollment Process

- Complete application for low-income eligible families
- You will be notified of the status of your application the week of March 21, 2023
