Assignment Directions:

- Log onto www.codehs.com
- **Create an account using your .info email address.**
- Click on join class on the left side column and enter the class code **0D522**
- Click on Unit 2 Basic Java.
- Watch all the videos and complete all 16 lessons which include activities, quizzes and tests for basic java only.
- You must complete all of Chapter 2 - Basic Java. When responding to the question items, the icon will turn green if it is correct, A yellow icon indicates that you tried/responded, but the answer is not correct. For the activities you will be able to submit and check your answers as many times as you would like. The quiz and test questions will only allow you to submit once.

Scoring/Grading:

- The AP Computer Summer Assignment is worth a 25 point assessment grade and a 38 point homework grade.
- The test at the end (lesson 16) will count as a quiz grade. Each question on the test is worth 1 point each for a total of 25 points.
- The exercises and quizzes will count as a homework grade and are worth are worth 38 points total. Each exercise and quiz is worth 1 point each. There are 23 labs/assignments and 15 quizzes.

This will count as your first classwork and assessment grade. The assignment is due on September 13.
